REGISTRATION:

The IAFF uses an electronic system to register students for classes and for the evaluation process at the conclusion of class, which also enables them to obtain their certificate electronically. This allows more effective use of classroom time. I have attached the registration template for this class to this e-mail and have included it below.

Registration procedure: The students should follow the directions on the template when they register for the class. If they are IAFF members, they should use the first box with the red button in the template to register. They should follow the directions on the registration page and submit their order. They should receive a confirmation e-mail confirming their registration.

If they are IAFF members, but have not logged into the IAFF website before or if they have forgotten their user name or password, they should click on the box that says "CLICK HERE IF YOU HAVE FORGOTTEN YOUR PASSWORD OR IF YOU ARE A MEMBER WITHOUT A LOGIN".

IAFF MEMBERS SHOULD USE ONE OF THE ABOVE BOXES. IF THEY ARE IAFF MEMBERS, USING THE BOX THAT HAS THEM CREATE A PROFILE CREATES A DUPLICATE RECORD FOR THEM IN THE MEMBERSHIP SYSTEM.

For personnel who are <u>not</u> IAFF members, they should use the lowest box with the red button. It will take them to the IAFF website where they will create a profile, including their home address. They will then go through the rest of the steps to complete the registration process and submit their order. They should receive a confirmation e-mail confirming their registration.

Evaluation Surveys and E-Certificates: Upon completion of the class, the students should look for an email that has the survey/evaluation link for the class. They should complete the survey to get their ecertificate.
