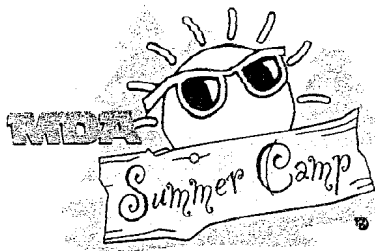

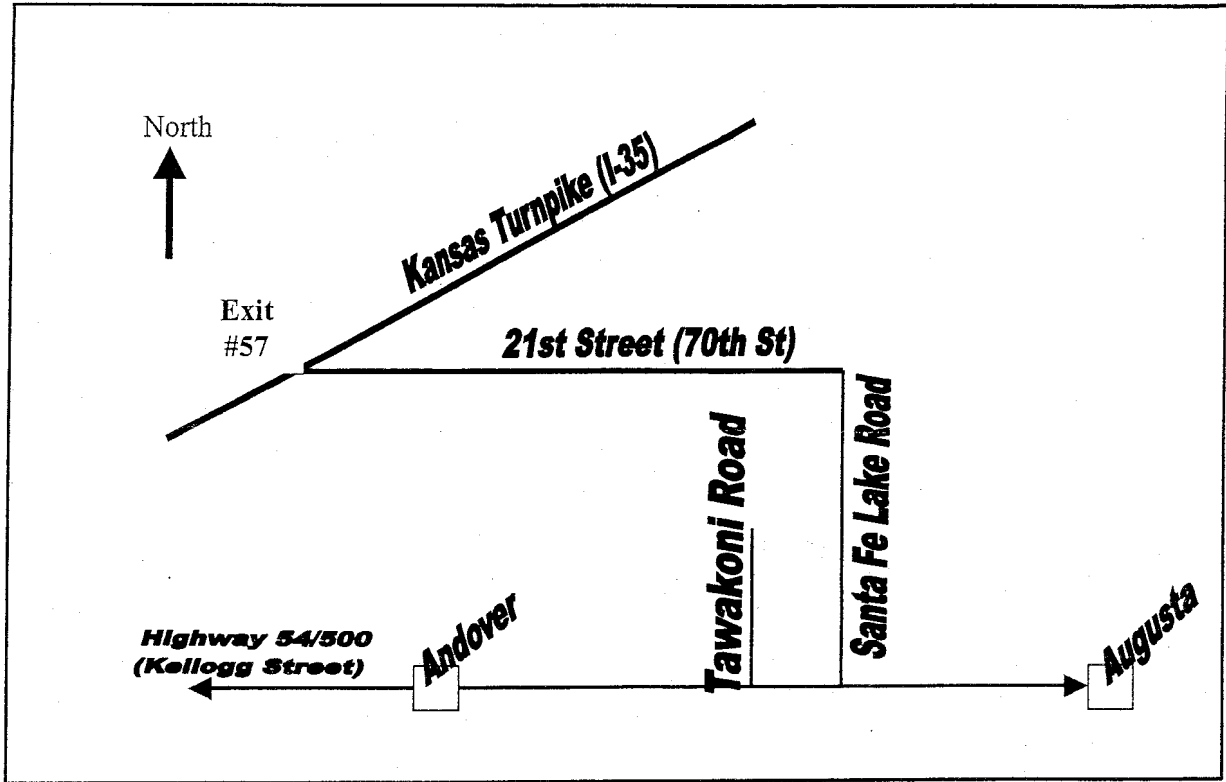
Friday: Pirates of the Caribbean

Directions to Kansas Disciple Center at Camp Tawakoni



FROM TOPEKA, ON KANSAS TURNPIKE

Exit at Andover (exit #57) and turn right (east) on 21st St (it becomes 70th St at some point). After 4 miles, turn right (south) to Santa Fe Lake Road. After 3 miles, turn right (west) onto Highway 54/400. After 1 mile, turn right (north) onto Tawakoni Road (gravel road) and drive 1.5 miles to the camp entrance (on your right, or east, side).

FROM SALINA, ON I-135

Exit on East Kellogg (Highway 54/400). Drive 3 miles east of Andover. Turn left (north) onto Tawakoni Road (gravel road) and drive 1.5 miles to the camp entrance (on your right, or east, side).

FROM THE WEST, ON HIGHWAY 54/400

Continue through Wichita (on East Kellogg). Drive 3 miles east of Andover. Turn left (north) onto Tawakoni Road (gravel road) and drive 1.5 miles to the camp entrance (on your right, or east, side).

FROM THE EAST, ON HIGHWAY 54/400

Drive 4 miles west of Augusta. Turn right (north) onto Tawakoni Road (gravel road) and drive 1.5 miles to the camp entrance (on your right, or east, side).
